

Summer Reading Instructions

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to St. Pius X Summer Reading Program. Now that the school year is ending and summer is about to begin, we look to you, parents and guardians, to assist us in providing students with summer reading opportunities.

The goal of this program is to encourage students to read for pleasure as they continue to refine their reading skills. Therefore, the reading assignments that are given in this program are grade appropriate and geared to be leisurely so that the students enjoy the process. Parents/guardians are encouraged to read with their child/children and **initial** in the designated areas on each form when the assignment is completed. Students are not to choose books they have already read.

Students entering grades 1st through 3rd:

1. Open the summer reading link for grades 1-3.
2. Download the reading log to your computer.
3. Fill in the titles of all of the books that you read this summer and have your parents initial in the designated box.
4. Print out the log and bring it with you on the first day of school.

The first day of school is Monday, August24, 2015.

Students entering grades 4th and 5th:

1. Open the summer reading link for grades 4-5.
2. Download the reading report to your computer.
3. You are required to read 2 books, complete the assigned reading report for both books and have your parents initial in the designated box.

4. Print out the log and bring it with you on the first day of school.

The first day of school is Monday, August24, 2015.

Students entering Middle School:

1. Open the summer reading link for Middle School.
2. Download the reading report to your computer.
3. You are required to read 2 books, complete the assigned reading report for each book and have your parents initial in the designated box.
4. Print out the log and bring it with you on the first day of school.
