Each exam is worth two major test grades, which average into the third trimester average. This could significantly raise or lower an average. The exams should be taken very seriously.

Also note the following policies:

2. Any inappropriate behavior during the exam, such as talking, passing notes, making noises, etc. are distractions to other students trying to do their best. The following consequences will occur:
  - A) A drop of one entire letter grade for each disruption will be reflected on the exam (6<sup>th</sup> grade only)
  - B) Students will receive a zero for that exam score. (7<sup>th</sup> grade only)
