We are working on plans to give you an opportunity to briefly meet your child's teacher and drop off supplies during the week of August 17th. We will schedule specific days throughout the week. Stay tuned!

Before School and After School CARES

Before School CARES

- Will be held in the Parish Hall.
- We will offer Before School CARES as early as 6:00 am.
- Before School CARES drop off is at the side door of the Parish Hall.
- All students will get a temperature check before entering CARES and those with a temperature over 100 will be sent back home with you.

After School CARES

- Will be held in the Parish Hall until further notice.
- Pick Up will be at the side door of the Parish Hall.

Morning Drop off and Afternoon Pick Up

Morning Drop Off - We are working on a plan that offers multiple drop off points depending on your child / children's grade level (you would stay in the car). All students will get a temperature check and those with a temperature over 100 will be sent back home with you. Parents will not be permitted to enter the building in the morning.

For those students arriving late to school, a check in station will be located at the front office breezeway door. Students will get a temperature check and those with a temperature over 100 will be sent back home with you. As usual, a parent / guardian will be required to sign in their student.

Afternoon Pick Up - There will be no Carpool A in the afternoon until further notice. All cars will line up in the Carpool B parking lot (Gym Parking Lot). Lines of cars will be directed along to the Breezeway to pick up their child / children. We will lead students to the breezeway when their parent / guardian drives up.

Classroom Procedures

- In each classroom, we will be able to accommodate all of our students allowing 3 feet - 6 feet distancing between students.
- We are working on plans and safety procedures to limit as much transition as possible throughout the school building and to facilitate those who need to transition out of their classroom.
- As per the Diocese: Face mask coverings are to be worn by students in grades 4-8 when they are at a distance of less than 6ft. in the classrooms or in communal spaces such as hallways, restrooms, school Masses, etc. Face mask coverings may be more difficult for our younger students in PK through 3rd grade but they are required to have masks with them and will be encouraged to wear them when they are at a distance of less than 6ft. in the classrooms and in communal spaces such as hallways, restrooms, school Masses, etc.

Lunch and Water Fountain Usage

- Lunches will be held in the classroom to begin the school year.
- There will be no hot lunch offered through the cafeteria initially. We hope to phase in hot lunch after a few weeks.
- All students will be asked to bring in their own lunch and snacks.
- In lieu of using school water fountains to start the school year, Students will be allowed to bring water bottles so they have water during the school day.
- Milk will not be offered initially for grades K - 8. We will monitor milk prices and hope to phase that offering in soon. Due to state regulations, white milk will be available to order for our Early Learners (Prek-3) and Junior Kindergarten (PreK-4) students.
- To limit the need for faculty / staff to assist with your student's lunch (opening items, etc.), please begin practicing with your child to make sure it is manageable for them.
