Dear St. Pius X Families,

My prayers go out to each of you as we usher in the new year. I hope that 2021 will be bright for our entire St. Pius X School community.

As we continue to grow our community, I want to inform you that St. Pius X has received steady and increased interest from new families regarding enrollment for next year. Mrs. Burfield, our Admissions Coordinator, is fielding calls and scheduling tours to potential families almost daily. Their interest is due in large part to what we have offered our students during the pandemic combined with dissatisfaction with their current school(s). This is great news for St. Pius X moving forward.

Because we are uncertain of what next school year will bring regarding the pandemic, we will proceed under current guidelines for social distancing in classrooms. This means that our classroom space will continue to have limitations regarding student capacity.

Our current families are our priority for the upcoming year. In order to accommodate our current families, we are opening re-enrollment of current students on January 15, 2021. We are working with FACTS to introduce online re-enrollment. This will simplify the process for our current, returning families. I ask that current families fill in and sign their re-enrollment contracts and submit fees as soon as possible. When your re-enrollment contract is signed and if current financial obligations are up-to-date and on time, your enrollment will be secured. (*Note - financial obligations must be up-to-date and on time to maintain enrollment status for the 2021-2022 school year.)

We will open applications for new families during Catholic Schools Week beginning on February 1, 2021. We will accept applications and contracts from these families for enrollment as soon as they are finalized.

Please know that the other local Catholic schools are in similar situations regarding registration, contract and securing spots due to space in their grade levels, so don't delay in returning your registration and contract to our front office.
